

## **Tiger Program Achievements and Electives for 2009 Day Camp**

### **Every day:**

- [Achievement – 5F]: Go outside and watch the weather.
- [Achievement – 5G]: Go on a hike.
- [Elective - #6]: Along with your partner teach a song to your family or den and sing it together.
- [Elective - #22]: With your family or with your den, have a picnic.
- [Elective - #35]: Play a game outdoors with your family or den (bucket brigade, rocket balloons, Duck, Duck, Goose, etc.).
- We covered seven of the eight Bobcat Trail requirements for the Bobcat badge. The partner and the scout need to complete the eighth track together. All of the Bobcat requirements are listed toward the front of the Tiger Cub handbook. I encourage everyone to get a copy of the handbook (new or used). When you meet with your den in the fall, be sure to help the other new Tiger scouts learn and earn the Bobcat badge.

### **Monday:**

- [Elective - #29]: Talk with your adult partner when you should use sunscreen.

### **Tuesday:**

- [Elective - #7]: Make a musical instrument and play it with others (Rainsticks).
- [Elective - #30]: Plant a seed (Seed pots and watermelon, cantaloupe, carrots, or cucumbers seeds).

### **Wednesday:**

- [Elective - #32]: Make a bird feeder and hang it outdoors.
- [Elective - #2]: Make a decoration ("Camp is Cool" embossed tin craft).
- [Elective - #4]: Make a frame for a family picture (Camp picture frames).

### **Thursday: Cancelled (moved to Friday)**

### **Friday:**

- [Elective - #17]: Make a model (we made a model of a cannon – Ping Pong Cannon).
- [Elective - #20]: With your den, make up a PSA (Public Service Announcement) skit to tell people about Tiger Cubs
